GETTING CONNECTED

STUDENT NETWORK ACCOUNTS

All students in Te Awamutu College (TAC) must have a valid school network account to use computers, to print, to access the internet and to receive email.

You need to have completed and handed in to your Form teacher an internet agreement form signed by your caregiver(s). Then an account will be created as per the following example:
