## POLICY STATEMENT ON LEARNING SUPPORT

## **Purposes**

- 1. All students will have their education needs met in individually appropriate ways.
- 2. Resources will be made available to meet the needs of students requiring remedial help or extension (learning support).
- 3. Wherever possible the student will be fully integrated into the mainstream.
- 4. The responsibility for evaluation of the need for individual programmes rests with the HOD Learning Support in consultation with Learning Support Co-ordinators, Deans, teachers, students, parents/caregivers and support people/agencies.
- 5. Class teachers of students needing additional learning support are responsible for curriculum adaptation with the support of the HOD Learning Support, Learning Support Co-ordinators, RTLB and Learning Support Assistants.
- 6. The Student Welfare Committee offers support in removing barriers to learning.
- 7. Opportunities will be made for professional learning and development for all staff working with students who have learning support needs.

## Guidelines

- 1. The HOD Learning Support will liaise with contributing schools to identify prospective students needing learning support/extension.
- 2. At enrolment, students requiring additional learning support are referred to the HOD Learning Support.
- 3. Referrals of students needing support and/or causing concern should be made after a referral to the Learning Support Co-ordinators for evaluation. (Referrals to RTLB should be made by Senior Leadership, HOD Learning Support or Learning Support Co-ordinators.)
- 4. Year 9 diagnostic testing is used for identification of students needing learning support/extension.
- 5. Students may be supported by Learning Support Assistants in classes and/or withdrawn for extra tuition and support.

- 6. Individual programmes are developed by the Learning Support Co-ordinators and/or HOD Learning Support with the Class Teacher and put in place where needed.
- 7. Individual Education Plan (IEP) meetings (for individual students) are held at least once a year but changes can occur as the need arises, after consultation with parents/caregivers, MOE LS etc.
- 8. HOD Learning Support and Learning Support Co-ordinators liaise with outside agencies for funding, technology and learning & behavioural support as needed and appropriate.
