The General Secretary of the Post Primary Teachers' Association has advised the Board Chair of the immediate withdrawal of all strike notices currently in effect from the PPTA.

What does this mean?

Rostering home ends immediately.

ALL year levels should attend each school day from now on.

Take note: Regional Paid Union Meetings as notified will still take place. They are a legal entitlement and NOT strike action.

PPTA members will discuss the arbitration process and the move onto individual employment agreements for all members from 1 July.

Earlier today I sent out via email and also posted on our website (see Our News) what the Paid Union Meeting (28 June) and the Junior Report Meeting (29 June) mean for the schedule for the 2 days.

4 periods (classes) are still happening on both days and students are expected to attend. Teaching and learning will occur.
