POLICY STATEMENT ON PROFESSIONAL LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT OF TEACHING STAFF

Rationale

A positive staff development programme will enhance the education opportunities of students and improve the capabilities of all staff.

Guidelines

- 1. Professional Learning and Development will be available to all staff to enable improved teaching and learning to take place and to promote professional growth for all staff.
- 2. Participation in professional learning and development is required by the Standards for the Teaching Profession and the Code of Professional Responsibilities (Teaching Council of Aotearoa New Zealand).
- 3. Professional Learning and Development programme and budget is established and administered by the Principal in consultation with appropriate staff.
- 4. Professional Learning and Development programme will reflect curriculum, individual and school wide objectives.
- 5. Applications for Professional Learning and Development should be in writing and costs sated along with the methods of reporting back or implementation.
- 6. Professional Learning and Development activities must be able to show a clear link to:
 - Pedagogy (teaching practice)
 - School curriculum
 - Assessment and reporting
 - Professional development via the Appraisal/Performance Management process
 - School wide targets and goals as established by the Strategic and Annual Plan
