PROCEDURE - FUNDRAISING

Rationale

The Board accepts that effective fundraising is an asset to the school.

Purposes

- 1. Fundraising is conducted appropriately to raise funds for approved events/organisations/teams/clubs.
- 2. Fundraising will provide an opportunity for groups to effectively plan for and conduct a fundraising venture.
- 3. Funds raised will be spent on outcomes approved.

Guidelines

- 1. Mufti Days are usually held once a term and generally raise money for charitable/humanitarian organisations (selected by the Service Committee, with Principal's approval).
- 2. School groups may fundraise (at school or outside school) at any time with the Principal's approval.
- 3. School groups who wish to fundraise through external funding sources (eg Grassroots Trust) must follow procedures and gain Board approval.
- 4. Funds raised must be paid into an approved school account.
- 5. The Board acknowledges that the Te Awamutu College Fund held by Momentum Waikato, is an official fundraising mechanism of the school.

Conclusion

Fundraising should be a minor component of the school day-to-day operations.
