PROCEDURE - FUNDRAISING

Rationale

The Board accepts that effective fundraising is an asset to the school.

Purposes

1. Fundraising is conducted appropriately to raise funds for approved events/organisations/teams/clubs.
2. Fundraising will provide an opportunity for groups to effectively plan for and conduct a fundraising venture.
3. Funds raised will be spent on outcomes approved.

Guidelines

1. Mufti Days are usually held once a term and generally raise money for charitable/humanitarian organisations (selected by the Service Committee, with Principal's approval).
2. School groups may fundraise (at school or outside school) at any time with the Principal's approval.
3. School groups who wish to fundraise through external funding sources (eg Grassroots Trust) must follow procedures and gain Board approval.
4. Funds raised must be paid into an approved school account.
5. The Board acknowledges that the Te Awamutu College Fund held by Momentum Waikato, is an official fundraising mechanism of the school.

Conclusion

Fundraising should be a minor component of the school day-to-day operations.
